If anyone has more new ideas for additional activities or changes to next year's event, please contact us. We will begin planning next January and would love all additions and ideas for improvement.

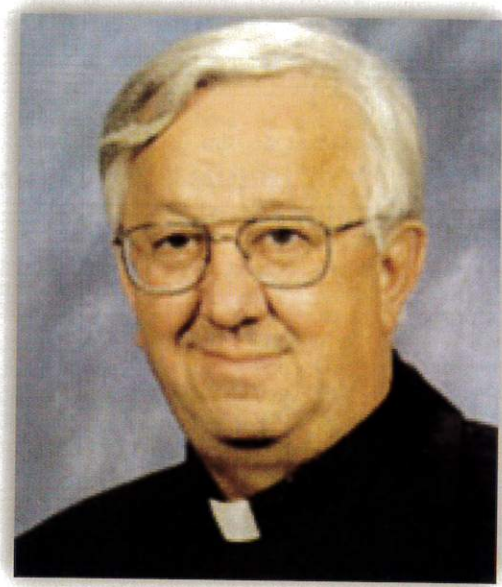
