The meeting was called to order by President Cody Washam.

The meeting opened with a prayer by Father Matt.

The minutes from the last meeting were read by Secretary Bonnie Parrigon and approved by the Council.

Financial Report: Joe Crowell mentioned that he was hoping a few end of year donations came in. Shelley mentioned a couple had been turned in.

Old Business

- Concerning the chimney on the church, we need to do some measuring to see what type of equipment we will need to rent. Mike Kaiser called the man who was working on the Methodist Church in Monett. He has not heard back from the man. Tim Dieckhoff offered to bring his lift. The day was icy when they were bringing it, so he was not able to bring it. He no longer has the lift. United Rental is quite expensive. Shelley mentioned tree trimmers with the county may have some equipment that will work, but it was decided their equipment was not big enough to go up and over.
- Another day will be set up to work on the walls leading up to the choir. Michael Sloan contacted Sergio to look at the wall. He will schedule a time to bring Sergio down. After he looks at it, we can set a work date.
- The security in the church was discussed
- The parking lot still needs some work. Dale Jasumback has it on his agenda. Once the weather cooperates he will work on it.
- The church/school website still needs some content for it. Cody gave us a list of what is needed. Shelly mentioned the church roster will not be on the website as too many people requested not to be on it. She is also working on a Facebook page for the church.

New Business

• The Gym Rental Agreement was discussed. The committee has emailed and communicated with one another. Some of the wording was discussed with the Council. The Council agreed to raise the rental fee amount and the utilities fee amount. The Council also agreed to various wording changes.
