

Meeting Minutes 1/22/2020

Members of St. Mary's School Board met on Wednesday, January 22nd, 2019 at 7:00 p.m. in the Rectoryconference room. Present were: Father Matt, Adam Boman, Andrew Eckhart, Jason Kramer, Amber Heidlage-Cole Jennifer Garner, and Jarrod O'Hara. Absent was Fares Masri.

In Fares' absence, the meeting was called to order by Vice-President, Adam Boman.

Opening prayer was led by Father Matt.

Minutes of last meeting were reviewed. Motion was made and seconded to approve minutes. Motion passed.

### Finance Report

Finance report for the month was reviewed.

- Phone: Dropped the land-line and combined school and parish to IP phone. This will result in approximately \$4,000/year.
- Utilities: With new LED lighting, is this saving money vs traditional lighting? Mr. Kramer will pull old bills in the spring or summer to compare and determine savings.
- Vacuum/wax machine was purchased for \$800. \$400 for school, \$400 for parish.
- Motion to approve was made by Jarrod O'Hara and seconded by Andrew Eckhart. Motion passed.

#### Father's Report

- Father reported the students were amazing during Advent.
- Participation in mass continues to improve and kids are working hard together both at church and in school.
- Notes that it is apparent the students are encouraged to learn and ask questions.

### Teacher's Report

## Principal's Report - Jason Kramer

- Mr. Kramer provided updates on the school.
- Events thus far have been well attended and well received.
- Upcoming events:
  - Writer's Guild Awards: January 25. St. Mary's is hosting a writing competition for 8 schools on the west side of the diocese for 3<sup>rd</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades. Various publications are sponsoring, and St. Mary's will host both a mass and catered banquet awards dinner following in the gym. Great way to kick off Catholic Schools Week.
  - 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Retreat: April 22. St. Mary's will host a retreat for all west side diocese 5<sup>th</sup> graders to include games, activities, fellowship and retreat.
- Parent involvement: It has been suggested to form and implement "circles" such as those used in PCCW to assist in coverage
  of work shifts.
- I-Ready Assessments: Finishing up 2<sup>nd</sup> round of testing, 3<sup>rd</sup> round will take place in March,

#### Old Business

- Mercy Monday: On Jan 27, Mercy Monday participants will again assist with helping set up at the Monett Food Pantry. Still
  considering activities for the upcoming months.
- Website
  - Making progress, but still no live launch.
  - Still lacking some pictures and content.
- Windows and Doors
  - o Continue to gather more information, pricing, etc, to establish a plan.

## New Business

- Tuition
  - o Diocese provided cost of living increase: 2.3%
  - o Staff Expenses will increase from \$288,081.31 to \$294,707.18
  - o Total Expenses will increase from \$350,331.31 to \$360,069.68
  - o From July 2019-present, we have gained 13 students.
  - Tuition increase is inevitable, so several options for tuition increase were presented including: 2.3%, 5%, and 10%.
  - No decisions will be made, but board members were encouraged to talk to other school families, get feedback, and report back at next meeting.
