EXPOSITION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT WITH BENEDICTION: Christ's Presence in the Blessed Sacrament is a great gift to us. His real presence in the manner of a substance is a mystery central to our faith. The Church provides us with a very special way of spending time in his presence through Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament As a Parish, we need to find one Friday a month to set aside time for this grace filled devotion. It requires at least from Noon to 7:00 P.M. Benediction, blessing of those assembled with the Blessed Sacrament, closes out Exposition. During the hours of Exposition, at least two people must be in the church. This does NOT mean that ONLY two can be in Church. During the full time of Adoration, all are welcome and encouraged to come and spend time. This would require people signing up for time slots, as well as having a list of those who are willing to be "on call" should the person who signed up for the time gets sick, or cannot otherwise be available. For this to get well established there must be a willingness to commit to signing up for six months. We need to know which Friday of the month will work best for everyone. We need to get a good sense of this by the end of Advent. Please let Fr. Matt know your thoughts on this question. The plan is to get sign ups in progress, so that we can begin in Lent (March 2022). Thank you.
