

through the Holy Spirit. God gave us that same Spirit, that same Wisdom, that same Truth, but the gift is useless unless we submit to the Spirit's purifying activity.

Of the Trinity, it's the Father who forgives sins. It's Jesus who delivers the forgiveness. And it's the Holy Spirit who sanctifies us and empowers us to go and sin no more.

In the confessional, the priest is the presence of Jesus



of Christ (which is the Church). Absolution is an action of his Holy Spirit, but it's more than just the removal of guilt; it replaces the sinful vice with the virtue that will help us avoid that vice in the future. The Sacrament of Confession is a direct contact with the Holy Trinity who embraces our repentance and transforms us to increase our holiness.

To receive this grace,

we only have to be open to it and interested in cooperating with God. Humility is necessary to be teachable and transformable.

The unanswered questions in our lives become personal revelations when we earnestly seek to do the Father's will in unity with Jesus while growing in holiness through the indwelling presence of his Holy Spirit.

- 1. Write a list of questions you have for Jesus. What do you have trouble understanding?
- 2. After making the list, ask the Holy Spirit to become your Teacher. Ask Jesus to help you become teachable.
- 3. What gift of the Holy Spirit do you find most helpful in guiding you through life's difficulties?
- 4. How does it help you to figure out and/or do the Father's will?
